

GREECE, EUROPE'S SEPTIC SINKHOLE

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Way before it was fashionable for the sensationalist media, not to mention the arcane, isolated mandarins in Brussels, to focus on illegal, overwhelmingly Moslem, immigration as the security threat of the future, we put it thus in [October 2008](#):

The uncontrolled flow of illegal immigrants into Greece has emerged as the primary strategic challenge this country faces in a regional environment that remains unsettled. Greek policymakers need to address this challenge urgently -- not with rushed plans to legalize all comers and not with words flying without deeds. Greece must begin a concerted effort to promote collective EU immigration rules, bring EU resources to bear on the defense of its borders, and impress upon conduit countries, like Turkey, that pushing illegal immigrants into Greece will be treated not in a "spirit of negotiation."

As early as August 2010, we [analyzed](#) the complete failure of what successive Greek governments called an "immigration policy" (that did not exist) and we stressed that this failure created a national security threat. In June 2014, we [warned](#) that, "... it is obvious that the European Union has reached a significant crossroads on illegal immigration where the usual rhetoric about 'humanitarian' policies simply won't do any longer;" and that, "It also appears imperative that a serious, all-round discussion of an active mass repatriation approach must be part of the agenda." And in May 2014, we also [warned](#) that the EU, by omission and commission, was "engaged, half consciously, half unconsciously, in building up its **negative relevance** in world affairs," a trend that appeared "irreversible."

Then, summer 2015 arrived.

As it was expected by the thinking (a rapidly diminishing species among European 'leaders'), the invasion of undocumented, and often violent, throngs from the Middle East, Asia, and Africa destabilized Europe in a matter of weeks.

In Greece, a so-called "leftist" administration, which though acts like the hardest-boned neo-liberal orderly of Greece's creditors, all but surrendered a country, already

undermined and subverted by untold masses of “irregular” undocumented entries. Europe’s “core,” under the incomprehensible “leadership” of Mrs. Merkel, was quickly immersed in a vituperative war of words with the European “union’s” eastern members demanding, in no uncertain terms, an active defense against the Moslem deluge. Greece, in the far corner of Europe, simply sat, twisted her thumbs, and waited for the whole edifice to come tumbling down upon her head.

With European “solidarity”-- a counterfeit concept that was nevertheless sold for decades to “united” Europe’s subjects as the panacea against all that is bad and evil -- disintegrating within days, the true face of Europe vis-à-vis the bothersome, quirky, and fraudulent Greeks is now revealed in all its glory. As the *Financial Times* newspaper [reports](#):

EU leaders are weighing a drastic plan to staunch the influx of asylum-seekers by blocking their passage into Macedonia, stoking fears in Athens that tens of thousands of migrants will become stranded in Greece.

The European Commission and Berlin are ready to back the proposal to aid Macedonia, a non-EU country, that would in effect isolate Greece, a fellow member-state that is economically fragile and already overwhelmed with migrants.

The implications for Greece, already devastated by the creditors’ “white” occupation and with only token sovereignty allowed her as a PR gimmick, are horrifying. Before the summer 2015 onslaught, various estimates put the illegal population of Greece close to anywhere from 1.4 to 1.8 million souls. Today, nobody knows where the figure stands. Greece’s northern border is already shut tight and her northern neighbors prudently put up serious defenses against the onslaught. But, the Greek government still refuses to begin acting like a *national* government and stop frolicking like a childish high school student council.

In terms of hard politics, this latest proposal to “ringfence” Greece delivers the explicit verdict on **what the European “union” means for Greece and her people and what should be the Greek attitude toward Greece’s “partners” from now on.**

The ringfence policy, already, if still unofficially, in place, leaves **no doubt** about the prospects of a relationship that was doomed from the outset—despite so many enthusiastic theories to the contrary by at least two generations of eager, but ill-advised, Greek “Europeanists.” The ringfence “solution” also delivers the proverbial slap to all those who descended on Constitution Square in Athens to demand a “YES to Europe” vote shortly before the [referendum](#) of July 5, 2015. From now on, they, just like the overwhelming majority who voted OCHI (‘NO’), will be subjected to the transformation of their country into the septic sinkhole of Europe by Brussels fiat.

Prospects now are:

1. Permanent destabilization of Greece’s eastern Aegean island country, with huge illegal migrant bottlenecks developing on both large and smaller islands, and with the possibility of arbitrary installation of European “union” control entities on sovereign

Greek soil acting outside the national legal regime and, practically, turning these islands into disputed territory—a fantastic boon to neighboring Turkey beyond its wildest dreams.

2. Collapse of the eastern Greek Aegean islands tourism, a vital foreign exchange earner for Greece.
3. Serious risks of violent migrant protests on the islands, with Greek populations facing severe security and personal safety threats.
4. Rapid increase of already swelling Moslem illegal migrant populations in mainland Greece, especially thanks to the Greek government's established tactic of transport-loose-and-forget that is overwhelming Athens.
5. Border crossing denial will inevitably lead to major concentrations of illegals developing near the northern frontier causing insurmountable security, public health, and resource scarcity crises.
6. Further crippling budgetary implosion as European "resource allocation" to the embattled Greeks will be linked, as it is already established practice, to the implementation of austerity measures demanded by the creditors—a criminal insanity under the current crisis.
7. Longer term affects upon Greek society, with the threat of a "multicultural," unthinkable Moslem hybrid emerging to push Greece back onto a historical past few believed it could be resurrected in the 21st century, with Europe's effective blessings, if not encouragement, as part of the lethal theory of a world without national borders.
8. Ultimately, the ringfence policy, is a **deliberate hostile act against Greece**, which must lead to a radical reassessment of the country's ties to an already disintegrating European "union," a possibility almost at hand as one of the most senior Eurocrats has [warned](#).

We do not expect the Tsipras administration to do *anything* of practical value under these calamitous circumstances. Indeed, if the past year is any yardstick, the established norm of Greek governments in general **always** failing to act in proportion to worsening conditions stands to roar to previously unknown heights under pressure of this crisis. The future is grim.
