Mr. Ilan Mizrahi – d. Director of MOSSAD / Director of National Security Council of ISRAEL

Ilan Mizrahi was the Deputy Director of the MOSSAD, with a career spanning over thirty years. He also served as Israel's National Security Advisor (**Director of National Security Council**) A specialist in Middle Eastern affairs, especially Iran and terrorism, his positions have included intelligence gathering and analysis, at both the tactical and strategic levels, and counter-terrorism. Mr. Mizrahi has held both field and headquarters positions, where he served as the head of the Counter-Terror Department and of the HUMINT and Intelligence Divisions. In his various positions he developed a broad network of contacts in the region and abroad, with leaders, senior officials and businessmen, as well as international organizations. He is a graduate of Islamic and Middle Eastern Studies at Tel- Aviv University.

John M. Nomikos (PhD) is the Director at the Research Institute for European and American Studies, Chairman of the Mediterranean Council for Intelligence Studies (MCIS), Chairman of the Greek Intelligence Studies Association (GISA), Founder of the Athens Security Forum (ASF) and Chairman of the European Intelligence Academy (EIA).

He is a Member of the Editorial Advisory Board for the International Journal of Intelligence and Counterintelligence (IJIC); the Advisory Board for the Police, Practice and Research Journal (PPR); Editorial Board of the European Journal of Intelligence Studies (EJIS); Editorial Board of the Journal for Intelligence, Propaganda and Security Studies (JIPSS); International Advisory Board for the World Security Network Foundation (WSN)

Prof. Manos Karagiannis

Emmanuel Karagiannis is Assistant Professor at the University of Macedonia's Department of Balkan, Slavic and Oriental Studies in Thessaloniki, Greece. He is also an Investigator of the University of Maryland's National Consortium for Study of Terrorism and Responses to Terrorism and a Research Associate of Bryn Mawr College in the United States. He obtained his Ph.D. in Politics from the University of Hull in 2000. He received his B.A in European Community Studies from London South Bank University and an M.A in International Security Studies from the University of Reading. He was a Postdoctoral Fellow at the University of Pennsylvania in 2005 and a Visiting Scholar at Yale's University Macmillan Center for International and Area Studies in 2008. During 2010, he spent his sabbatical at Princeton University as a Stanley J. Seeger Visiting Research Fellow. His new book Political Islam in Central Asia: The Challenge of Hizb ut-Tahrir was published by Routledge in 2010.
