**HOW TO LOSE BY BELIEVING YOU HAVE WON**

Those familiar with military history would have no difficulty in identifying how the “Remain-ers” lost the historic referendum of June 23, 2016, in a way that was almost predetermined as it was crushingly sweeping by a margin of over one million votes.

**First**, the “Remain-ers,” uniting forces that are rejected, if not hated, by hundreds of millions around the Western world, drew up a battle plan that assumed the peasants had no backbone for the fight.

**Second**, the “Remain-ers” launched an attack based entirely on fear-mongering and promises of another Biblical Flood if Britain stepped away from the German-dominated so-called “union.”

**Third**, the “Remain-ers” did not try to conceal their true feelings toward the peasants, looking upon them as racist uneducated coarse bigots dedicated to overturning a “multicultural society” that has been unilaterally ordained by loony liberalism as the only salvation from all Evil.

**Fourth**, the “Remain-ers” shed plenty of crocodilian tears over the murder of Jo Cox but, in what they thought was a shrewd underhanded way, they attempted to exploit the tragic demise of the mother of two to boost their campaign in favor of continuing to kowtow to Brussels and Berlin. Their effort backfired as even a junior social anthropologist would have told you.

**Finally**, the “Remain-ers” advanced with no fallback plan, no reserves, and the certainty it would all be accomplished “in eight weeks and before Christmas,” to remember the fantasies of Mrs. Merkel’s deranged Austrian ancestor who destroyed Europe between 1939 and 1945.

That the “Remain-ers” rout was complete is thus no surprise.

The deep fissures in the EU edifice are spreading; the disastrous German failure to attack illegal immigration in ways that nip the Moslem invasion of Europe in the bud; the malignant economic crisis that refuses to go away; the blazing resistance of EU mandarins to democracy; and the growing pressure upon individual member state identities by enacting ever growing regulations and demands without the slightest democratic legitimization promise a future that will shake the world.”*

In the aftermath, it is with justified *Schadenfreude* and a smile we read the horrified “analyses” of all those in the international media who predicted with little thought the unconditional surrender and eradication of the “Brexit-ers.” Commentary in the New York Times to the Guardian champion of loony liberalism; in almost every prominent newspaper in continental Europe to the global news agencies, Reuters, Bloomberg, etc.; and in regional and local sheets from Ireland to the far frontiers of Scandinavia, expressions like “explosive shock,” “unbelievable victory,” “a jump in the dark,” and a “vote for the unknown” dominated the output of winded editorial writers.

The immediate aftermath of the “Remain” crushing defeat will be convoluted. Already, all the forces that have promoted, nurtured, and imposed the Kingdom of Sovereign Debt, and are creating “wealth” and “investment” out of global computer transfers of non-existent values, are in feverish search for “solutions.” All these concerned “job creators” and “investors,” not to overlook corporate global bosses, are right to feel threatened because the historic British vote has special significance: it does not come from a country that can be browbeaten and kicked to the ground, like Greece, Portugal, Spain, and Ireland, by the likes of second-rate IMF clerks, the European Commission, the Reich ministries, and their willing executioner “assessors” carrying laptops instead of machine guns. It comes from a country that only seventy years ago stood alone

and unsupported against the Nazi Blitz, and under the unwavering leadership of Winston Churchill, carried the torch to the very victorious end.

Some may even be prompted to recall how this phlegmatic, iron-willed stance of the British people helped change the flow of world history as Hitler send his armies to destroy, conquer, and annihilate – and compare today’s Brexit vote to a resurrected spirit of hard-knuckled defiance British “progressives,” “multiculturalists,” “anti-racists,” “integrationists,” and lovers of “diversity” felt certain they had erased for good to the benefit of “not raising walls but breaking barriers” and promoting a pulp society.

It is also educational to study the breakdown of the referendum vote by region and large urban center. The only areas the “Remain” campaign won are urban Meccas of “multiculturalism,” with London up front – the same London that recently elected a Moslem mayor who has moved [to ban from public transportation “advertisements that promote unhealthy body images”](#) (read: bikinied women) and sees no problem in addressing public events of his co-religionists that are [segregated according to the Islamic manner](#) of placing women in the back of room behind the men. Londoner “cosmopolitans” apparently find nothing objectionable in this blatant attitude of their mayor known of having co-existed with many Islamic radicals and terrorist suspects.

The breakdown of the referendum vote by region and large urban center reveals how dis-united the “United Kingdom” has become after decades of its elites pushing hard to make the whole country abandon its basic “British” attitude that has been judged – by who, really? – unacceptable in this day and age of color blindness and earnest efforts to find excuses for “religions of peace.” Gone is the Empire and gone is England’s ability to rule the waves, but the core of the country, the vote on June 23 showed, has not lost its willingness to resist the “global government” onslaught even at this last moment.
